A poised, elegant expression of Chardonnay from one of the most unique terroirs in the world. When acclaimed winemaker Andrea Franchetti first discovered the steep volcanic slopes of Etna, he was enthralled with the wild landscape, realising its potential to create some truly expressive wines. With vines planted at 1000 meters, making them some of the highest Chardonnay vineyards in the world, Passobianco is simultaneously fresh, mineral, and aromatic. Bright notes of sea spray, grapefruit skins and hints of nectarine create a layered, spicy bouquet. The last vintage worked by Franchetti before his death, the 2020 is a tribute to a legendary Etna winemaker.

Cerasuolo di Vittoria DOCG, Gulfi, Sicily, 2021, Italy

On Sicily's extreme south-eastern tip lies the vineyards of Cerasuolo di Vittoria. The only region in Sicily to be granted DOCG status, it brings life to two of the island's native varieties. Traditional for the region, Gulfi blends Nero d'Avola, a brooding variety that develops impressive richness in the Sicilian heat, and Frappato di Vittoria, a lifted, fragrant grape famous for juicy wild red fruits. The combination is magic: a pure display of sweet violet florals and black cherry with a hint of pepper and herbal crunch. The texture is silky, enveloping the palate in bright raspberry and blueberry along with a refreshing wave of juicy acidity. As a winery which believes in the potential of these two varietals, the winemaking philosophy is simple, working with minimal intervention to make terroir expressive wines.

Pinot Grigio, Franz Haas, Vigneti Delle Dolomiti, 2023, Italy Franz Haas is one of the leading producers of white wine in northern Italy. His Pinot Grigio is sourced from vineyards ranging from 350m-800m altitude in the mountainous region of Alto-Adige in northern Italy, this wine boasts a bright acidity and mineral notes with aromas of green apple, pear and citrus.	39.95
Bergerie de l'Hortus, Famille Orliac, Pic Sant Loup, 2021, France A delicious crisp white blend. 40% Roussanne, 20% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Viognier, 10% Sauvignon Gris, 10% Chardonnay. Bergerie Blanc lights up the glass with pale, shimmering gold. The smooth, balanced palate tantalizes with complex notes of fresh herbs, white flowers, and citrus.	41.95
Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpote Hut, Marlborough, 2023, New Zealand Aromas of passion fruit, blackcurrant, lemongrass and fresh thyme make this a truly stunning example of a Marlborough Sauvignon.	42.95
Picpoul De Pinet, Brechallune, La Croix Gratiot, 2023, France A premium single vineyard Picpoul with bright notes of grapefruit, lemon, and white blossom on the nose. Picked slightly later than is common for the region and aged on its lees, the palate has beautiful presence and texture.	44.95
Aromatico, Protero, Adelaide Hills, 2022, Australia Inspired by the wines of Northern Italy, 'Aromatico' blends Gewürztraminer, Riesling and Sauvignon Blanc. Emphasising the grapes' natural aromatics, the nose shows vibrant lychee, ginger and dusty rose balanced by a zesty citrus spine on the palate. Exotic and delightful !	47.95
Albarino, Pazo Senorans, Rias Baixas, 2023, Spain This is a fine mineral-driven Albarino from the leading Albarino producer in Rias Baixas. Aromas of nectarine, fresh figs, orange zest and white flowers. Dry with citrus flavours and a mineral finish. Perfect with shellfish.	53.95

- Bourgogne Chardonnay, Jean-Claude Boisset, 2022, France** 55-95
Classic Burgundian Chardonnay made with a harmony of freshness and fruit expression from highly concentrated, low yielding vines. Bright citrus fruit, white flowers and a tight mineral palate is softened by gentle toasty oak notes.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Amphora, Gabrielskloof, 2022, South Africa** 54-95
This is atypical Sauvignon, and we love it for that reason. Amazingly concentrated, with a lovely waxy texture, a subtle salinity and quite restrained. Think juicy fleshy pear, ripe apple, pink grapefruit and clementine. On the palate it is soft, silky and weighty and that touch of salt lingers on for an eternity.
- Calvarino, Soave Classico, Pieropan, 2021, Italy** 57-95
Arguably the first single vineyard white to be made in Italy, this is a wine whose reputation precedes it. Clean and refreshing, the crystalline lemon and delicate elderflower merge on a pure, mineral driven palate. Mouthwatering and complex: classic Soave, done to perfection.
- Carjanti Bianco, Gulfi, Sicilia, 2019, Italy** 67-95
On Sicily's southeast coast, there are few people crafting wines as good as Gulfi. Working with indigenous and international grape varieties, this is a wine made from 100% organic Carricante grapes, 50% fermented in stainless steel and 50% in large used botti. Fresh and vibrant, boasting orchard fruit flavours such as peach and apple. The fruit follows through to a smooth and delicious palate, with a hint of almonds and lovely minerality.
- Falanghina, Via Del Campo, Quintodecimo, Campania, 2020, Italy** 69-95
Via del Campo perfectly expresses the fruity and mineral scents typical of Falanghina wine. This single vineyard Cru is characterized by a luminous golden colour and fragrances of apple, pineapple, herbs and field flowers with refined minerals and salty notes. The delicate structure, releases menthol and toasted notes arising from the short stay during the partial fermentation in barrel.
- Chablis Premier Cru, Cote Lechet, Les Hauts De Milly, 2022, France** 69-95
The Kimmeridgian clay soils in Côte de Léchet lend this wine a distinct saline edge and powerful character. The nose is fragrant with aromas of white flowers, lemon and apricot and hints of gunflint. On the palate are intense citrus fruit flavours and a persistent salinity which carry through to the long finish.
- 'Reid Ulm' Nussberg Wiener Gemischter Satz, Weininger, 2021, Austria** 69-95
From a single vineyard overlooking Vienna in the Nussberg foothills, this is a traditional field blend of nine grape varieties. As the centrepiece wine from the producer responsible for revitalising this speciality, 'Reid Ulm' is absolutely unique and a joy to drink. With shoots of gold in the glass, it has elegant aromatics of ripe white and yellow fruit - balancing a full bodied softness with a limestone mineral precision that refreshes each sip. Lush and concentrated with a lingering salinity.
- Icon, Santorini, Anhydrous, 2021, Greece** 99-95
The Icon Assyrtiko is made from old vines grown around the village of Pyrgos, the highest village of the island, and home to many of the best vineyards. Only 800 bottles of this wine were made. Dense fruit with the presence of sea breeze with remarkable saltiness. Dry palate with sharp acidity, minerality & flint. Rigorous, clean, strict, with a strong structure. An authentic expression of Santorini's majestic terroir.
- Aliot, Vin de Pays de Vaucluse, Chene Bleu, 2015, France** 99-95
This vibrant yet mature white exhibits the curious aging curve of Rhône-white blends. A Roussanne-dominant wine blended with smaller proportions of Grenache Blanc and Marsanne and then matured eight months in oak, it's rounded and weighty but maintains a core of pert white pear and lemon flavours. Delicately smoky and kissed by honey, nougat and almond. Stunning !

- Altopiano, Terre Di Chieti Rosso, Abruzzo, IGT 2022, Italy** 28.95
100% montepulciano. Ruby red with red berry fruits, wild cherries & violet with a delicate spice & soft tannins.
- Carignan, Vieilles Vignes, Mont Rocher, 2021, France** 29.95
100% carignan from old vines producing a well-structured wine with dark berry fruit & spice on the palate with a zingy & uplifting finish.
- Merlot, Montes, Colchagua Valley, 2022, Chile** 29.95
Vibrant ruby red in colour, this plummy Merlot has hints of vanilla and chocolate with velvety tannins, crisp acidity and a fragrant finish.
- Mencia, Merayo, DO Bierzo, 2022, Spain** 32.95
Made from over 80 year old Mencia bush vines. There is no oak treatment to preserve the aromatic fresh red fruit quality of this variety. Fresh and herbal with a hint of spice on the finish.
- Cotes du Rhone Villages, Famille Perrin, 2021, France** 37.95
A blend of Grenache (70%) and Syrah (30%), this Côtes-du-Rhône Villages is made using the same viticultural and vinification techniques as those employed at Château de Beaucastel.
- The Blend, Gabrielskloof, Walker Bay, 2020, South Africa** 39.95
49% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petit Verdot, 7% Malbec This blend has aromas of delicate violets and black fruit, with hints of vanilla and tobacco leaf from the time in barrel. Fine velvety tannins and restrained power, balanced with bright acidity and a juicy palate.
- Shiraz, The Cunning Plan, Thistledown, McLaren Vale, 2022, Australia** 42.95
Fruit comes from the Moray Park vineyard in the McLaren Flat sub-region. Low yielding and ultra-intense, Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry fruit flavours. A full bodied wine with a succulent palate, lively spices and fine velvety tannins.
- Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, 2020, New Zealand** 47.95
Aromatics of ripe cherry & plum shine through to the palate & are complimented by subtle spicy notes with a silky & lingering finish.
- Malbec Blend, Disobedience, Kaiken, Mendoza, 2020, Argentina** 49.95
'Disobedience' by Francis Mallmann represents the long collaboration between the Argentinian chef and Kaiken. Known for his distinct style of open fire cooking this is a blend of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot sourced from Altamira and Vistalba. A rounded, rich wine with expressive sweet and spiced red fruit.
- Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Luis Canas 2017, Spain** 53.95
A delicious Reserva from one of the top Rioja Bodegas. It has a dark berry fruit nose and an elegant, flavourful blackberry and raspberry palate together with complex layers of oak, cocoa and balsam hints. Structure, elegance and length.
- Barbera D'Alba, DOC, G.D.Vajra, Piedmonte, 2023, Italy** 54.95
Scented, balanced and lively, Vajra's Barbera d'Alba combines wild forest fruit aromatics with ripe, thirst-quenching raspberry and blackberry with a hint of fig. A wine made with great character and intensity from one of our most favourite and also highly respected producers.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Nocturne, Margaret River, 2021, Australia** 55.95
For a great value, contemporary Margaret River Cabernet blend that over-delivers then look no further than this release from Julian Langworthy from Nocturne. The 'King of the North' blends Yallingup Cabernet Sauvignon with around 30% Merlot for a juicy, blue-fruited beauty with all the great spicy, mineral-dredged goodness that this unique region has to offer.

Cannonau Di Sardegna, Antonella Corda, 2021, Italy 63.95

Made from grapes perfectly ripened in Sardinia's Mediterranean climate and given a gentle maceration with non-toasted oak, Antonella Corda's Cannonau (Grenache) shows delicate, precise summer fruit notes of raspberry, cherry and rose petal. Pale ruby red, the wine has super soft tannins and a hint of white pepper to finish, allowing the elegant fruit to shine.

Ribera del Duero, Finca Villacreces, 2019, Spain 67.95

Made from a meticulous selection of the best vines from the estate's 15 vineyard plots. A perfect blend of 86% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Merlot. Inky purple, with an expressive bouquet of mocha/expresso, toasted bread, graphite, wild blueberries and blackberry liqueur. Full-bodied and plush on the palate, with layers of spicy black fruits and a smoky finish.

Passorosso, Passopisciaro, Etna Rosso DOC, 2021, Italy 69.95

This is a pioneering project from acclaimed winemaker Andrea Franchetti, the sequel to that of his iconic Super Tuscan estate, Tenuta di Trinoro. Made from Nerello Mascalese bush-vines planted between seventy and one hundred years ago on the wild volcanic ash soils of Mt. Etna, this is an holistic expression of the stunning breadth of flavours that Etna can produce. Aged in large, neutral oak barrels and unfiltered, the nuance and purity of the grapes is protected giving bright, red-fruit, mineral, and herbaceous aromas.

Moulin a Vent, Chateau du Moulin a Vent, 2015, France 99.95

Located at the heart of the prestigious Moulin-a-Vent appellation, from a vintage that was lauded as historic, comes this elegant powerful Beaujolais. Dark and glossy in the glass and bursting with juicy black cherry, dried violets and a faint spice, the wine has a surprising presence. The suave tannins feel softly integrated while the natural freshness of Gamay makes the wine dance across the palate. A hugely impressive & beautiful expression of the region !

Amarone della Valpolicella, La Giuva, 2018, Italy 99.95

With a complex and ethereal nose, the wine has aromatic notes of cherries, blueberries and chocolate, combined with hints of sweet spice. Smooth and powerful, the characteristic sweetness of the tannins gives this Amarone a depth and long fruity finish which makes tasting this wine an intense pleasure.

Pinot Noir, Applejack Vineyard, Giant Steps, 2021, Australia 99.95

Single vineyard Pinot Noir from Yarra Valley. Giant Steps has a reputation for delivering some of Australia's most consistent, over-performing wines. Acclaimed as the best vintage yet, the 2021 is stunning, oozing with spices, perfume and polish, featuring green cardamom, clove, lavender and nutmeg that add an aromatic overtone to wild berry, cranberry and strawberry pastry.

Rose

Rosa Dei Frati, Ca dei Frati, Riviera del Garda, 2022, Italy 46.95

From the stunning shores of Lake Garda, A delicate salmon pink wine that is fresh but full of flavour, showing delicate red berry fruit with poise & balance.

La Rosa, Can Sumoi, Serra De L'Home, 2023, Spain 49.95

Can Sumoi's commitment to organic and natural winemaking, combined with their vineyards in the Penedes mountains give rise to wines like La Rosa: blended from Sumoll, Parellada, and Xarello, this is a delicate blush pink with soft aromas of raspberry and wild florals leading to an elegant mineral finish.

Rose of Virginia, Charles Melton, Barossa Valley, 2021, Australia 59.95

A unique style of rosé from one of the most respected winemakers in the Barossa. Full-bodied yet crisp, it is vibrant cerise in colour, with a fragrant bouquet of Turkish Delight and maraschino cherry, with soft notes of spice.
